

## HOW TO USE A LANE CLEANER

### For optimum results using all lane cleaners:

- Always store diluted cleaner and cleaner concentrate at room temperature in a tightly closed container when not in use.
- Mix only enough cleaner for one to two days usage.
- Use room temperature (approximately 73°F or 23°C) water for dilutions.
- Do not let cleaner stand on lane surface for prolonged periods.

### Machine application using Formula ACC and Formula 388:

The exact dilution of a concentrated lane cleaner required depends on the degree of accumulated lane conditioner and grime to be removed from the lane. The following dilution ranges are suggested as a starting point. You may find that a stronger or weaker solution is needed in your specific situation.

#### Formula 388

1. Begin with an initial dilution of 6 parts water to 1 part of Formula 388.
2. Add 77 ounces (2277mL) to a 5-gallon (18.9L) mixing vessel.
3. Fill the mixing vessel to the five-gallon mark with water and stir to fully mix.

#### Formula ACC

1. Begin with an initial dilution of 5 parts water to 1 part of Formula ACC.
2. Add 103 ounces (3046mL) to a 5-gallon (18.9L) mixing vessel.
3. Fill the mixing vessel to the five-gallon mark with water and stir to fully mix.

### Hand application using Formula 388:

Formula 388 can be used for cleaning lanes by hand or when using a Strip 'N Dust. Follow the starting dilution suggestion as described below. Adjust the dilution as needed to clean your lanes.

1. Begin with an initial dilution of 8 parts water to 1 part of Formula 388.
2. Add 77 ounces (2277mL) to a 5-gallon (18.9L) mixing vessel.
3. Fill the mixing vessel to the five-gallon mark with water and stir to fully mix.

### Additional cleaning applications using Formula 388:

Formula 388 can be diluted and used for general purpose cleaning and degreasing applications around your center. The following applications and dilutions are recommended:

- Pinspotter, Pinsetter and Machinery Cleaning: 1 part Formula 388 to 5 parts water
- Bowling Balls and other hard surfaces: 1 part Formula 388 to 20 parts water
- Floors, Bowler's Area and Concourse Furniture: 1 part Formula 388 to 30 parts water
- Painted Walls and Surfaces: 1 part Formula 388 to 50 parts water (Do not use to clean water-based paints)
